  - Carbon Black
- Craftsmart paint (for the "toothbrush" stars)
  - o Bright Gold Multi Surface Premium Metallic Acrylic
  - White Satin Acrylic
- Paint brushes
  - Size will depend on the size of your pots
  - o Thick brushes for applying the sky and thin brushes for the stars
- Toothbrush
- White Sharpie oil-based paint pens
  - Fine point
  - Medium point (this larger size isn't necessary unless you want to be able to cover more area)
- Soil
- Plants of your choosing
  - Low maintenance plants
    - Pathos
    - Snake Plant
    - Cacti
